The Low-income measure, after tax, refers to a fixed percentage (50%) of median adjusted after-tax income of private households.

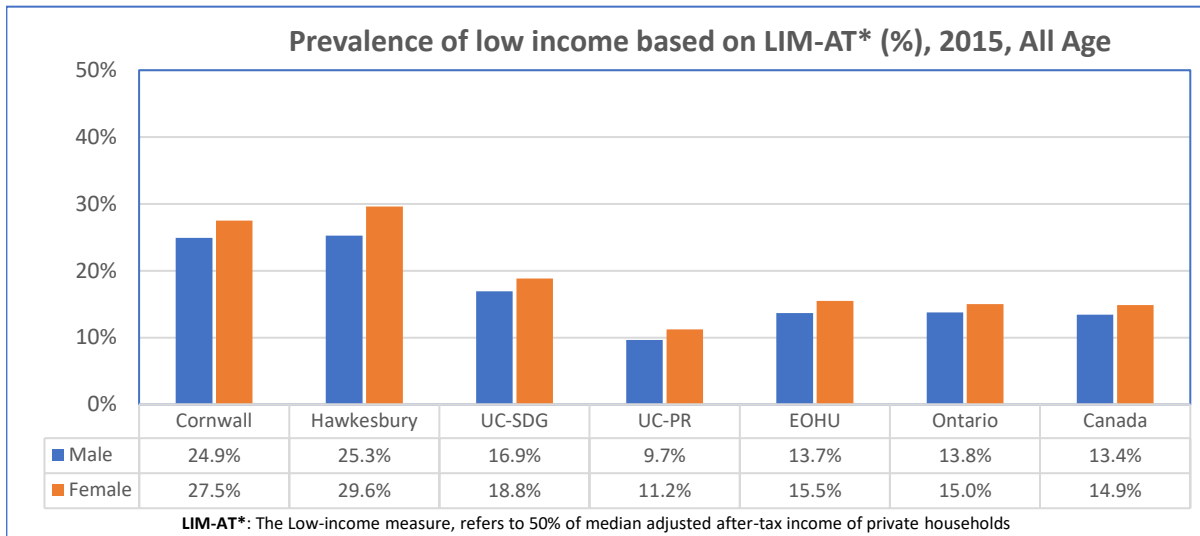
LICO-AT

The low income cut-offs (LICO) are income thresholds below which a family will likely devote a larger share of its income on the necessities of food, shelter and clothing than the average family.

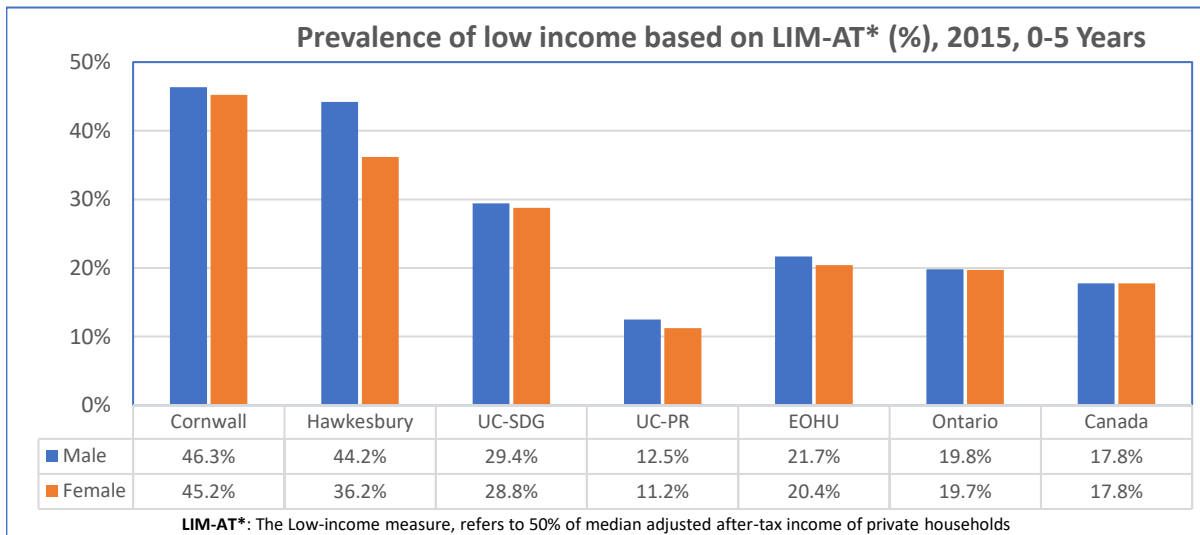

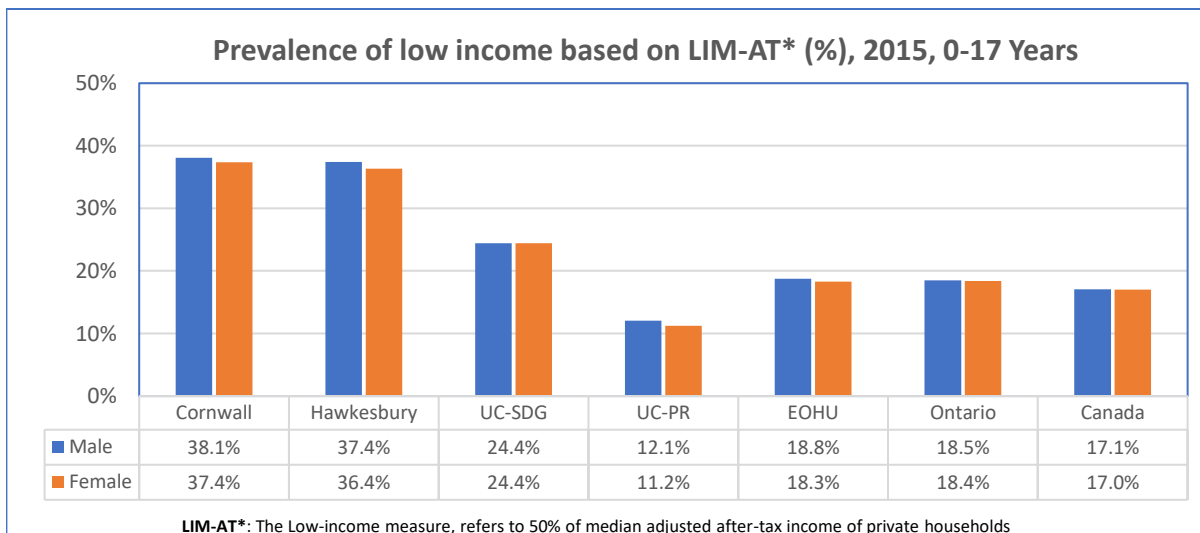

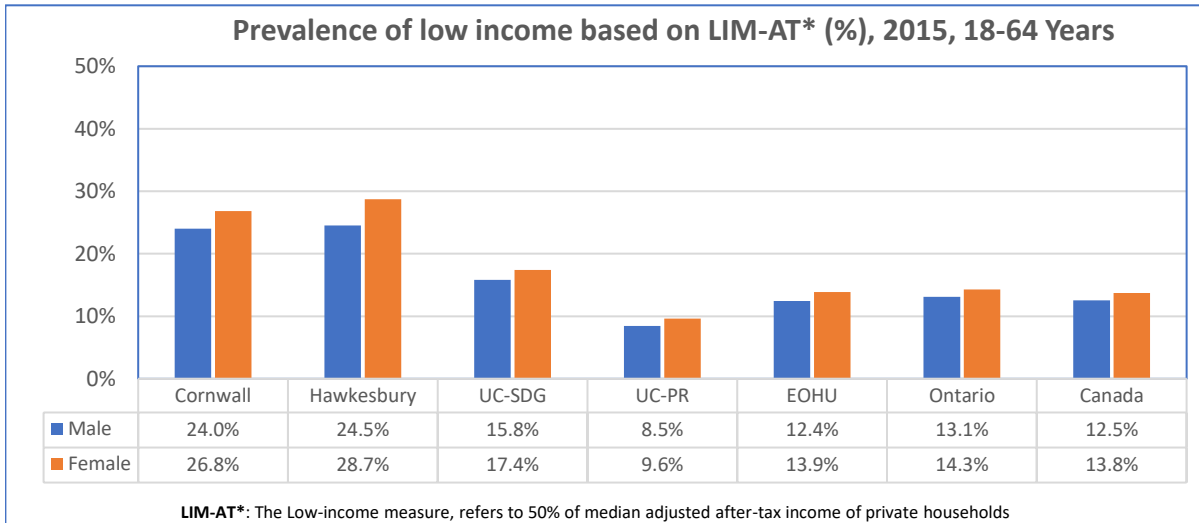

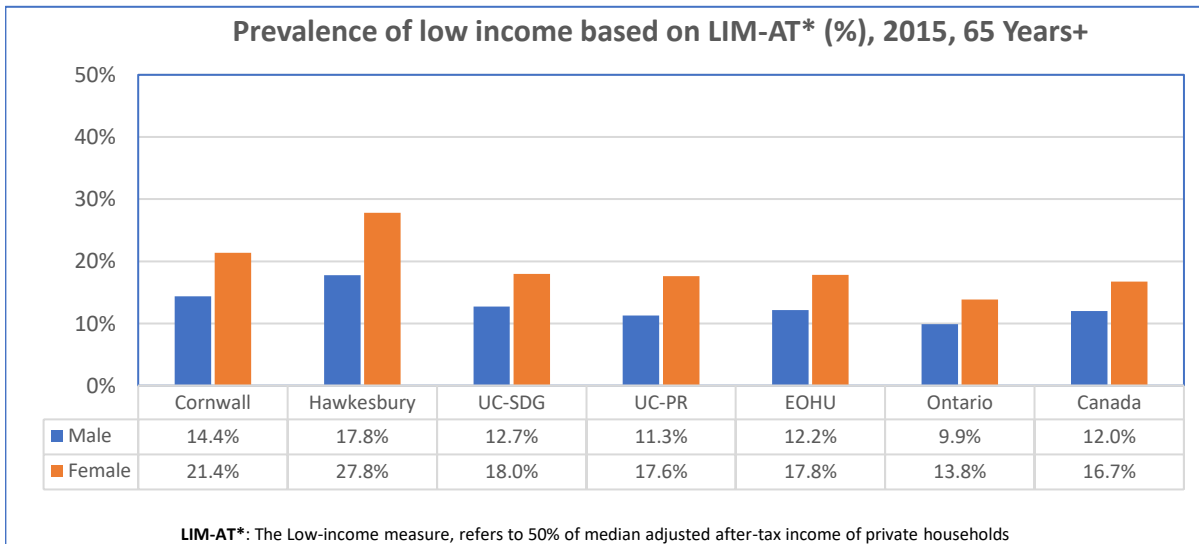
For 0-17 Years

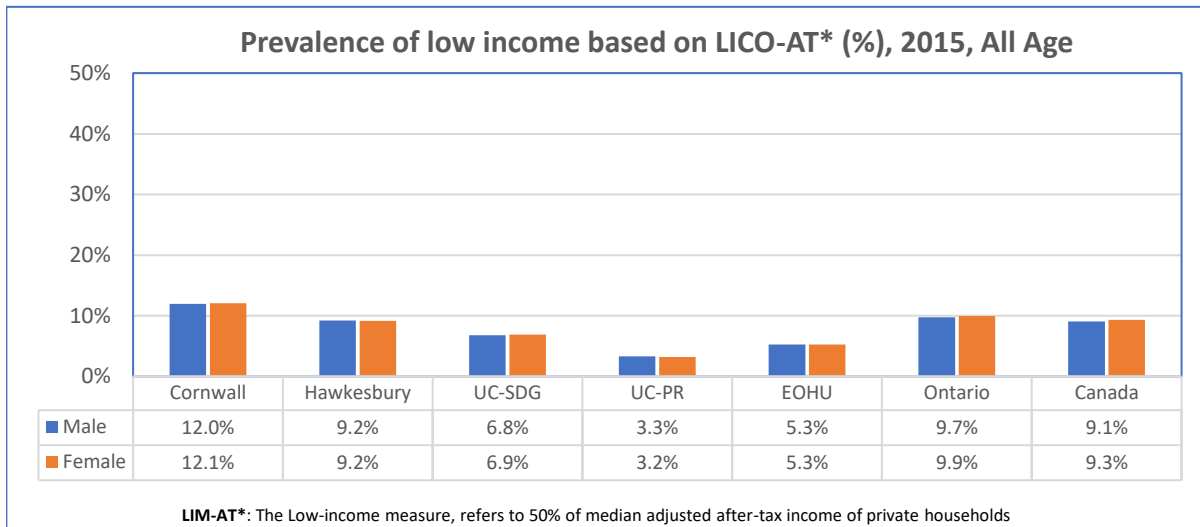

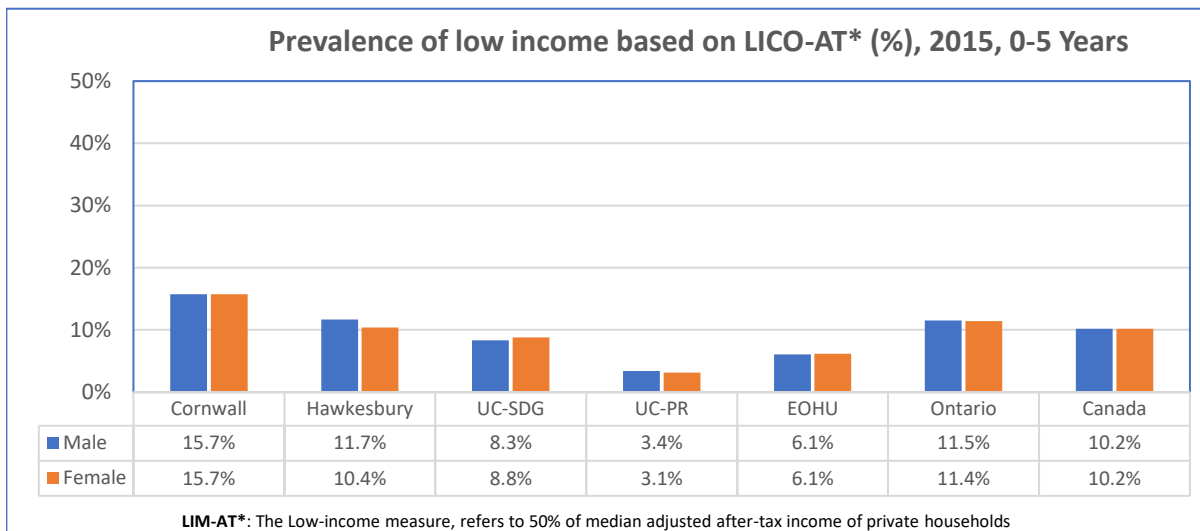
Prevalence of low income based on the Low-income cut-offs; after tax (LICO-AT) (%)

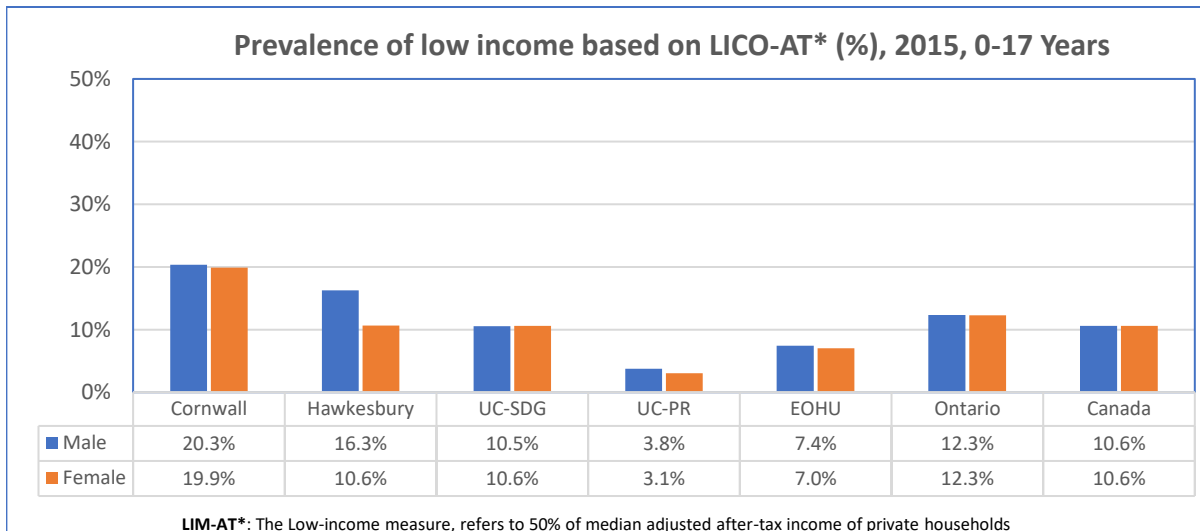

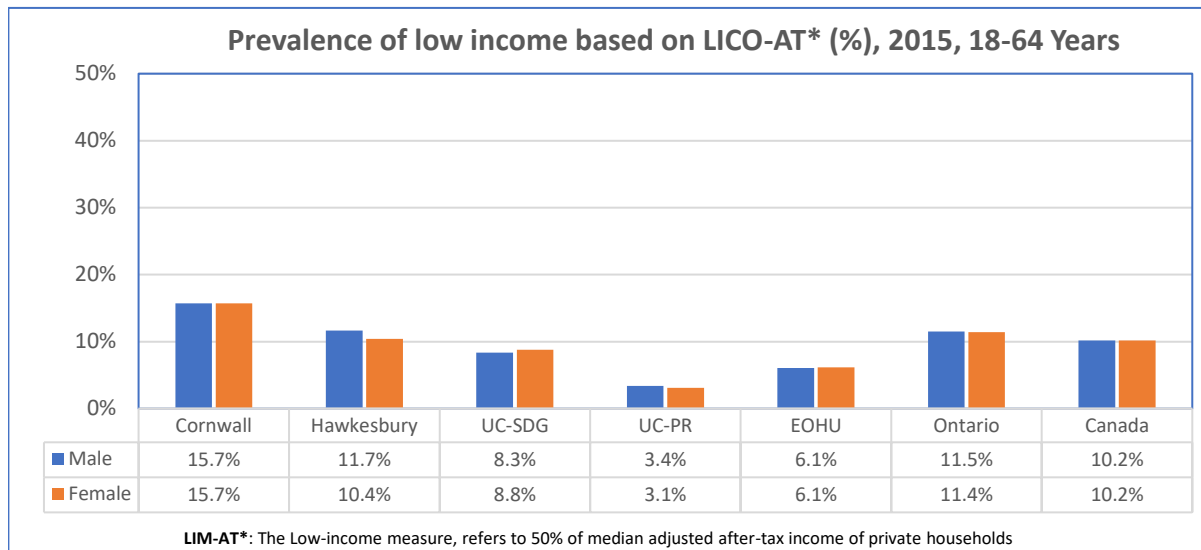

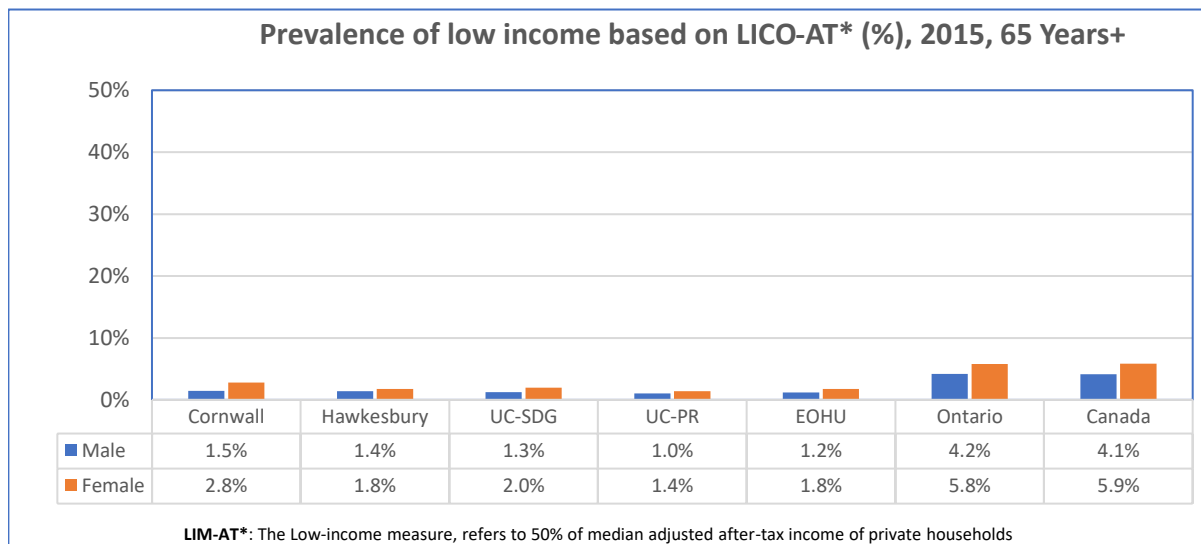
