Figure 10. Income Distribution for Aged 15 Years+ in Private Households, Male, 2020

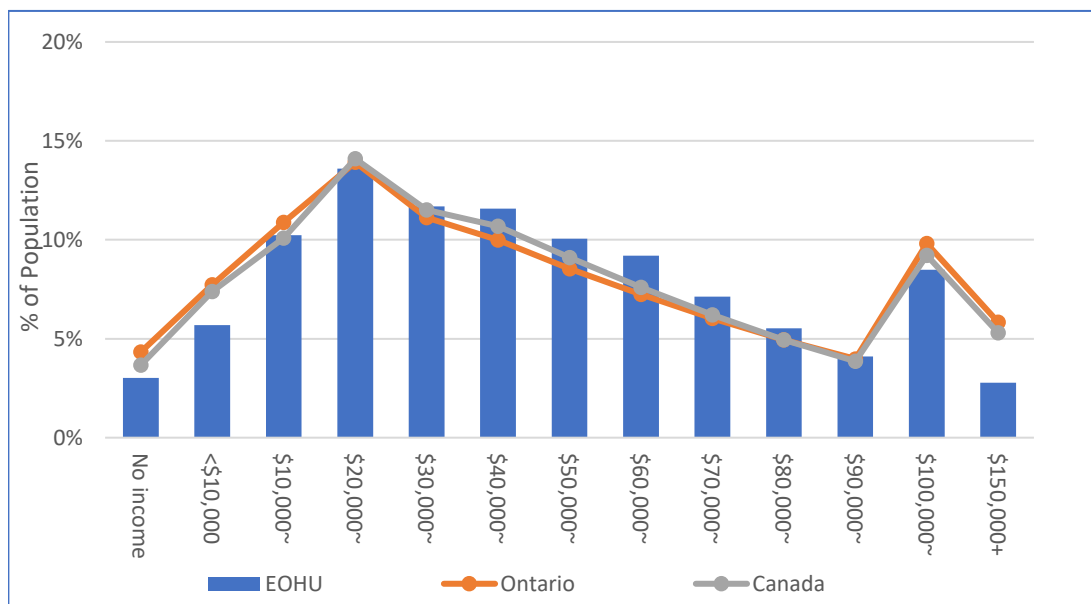

Figure 11. Income Distribution for Aged 15 Years+ in Private Households, Female, 2020

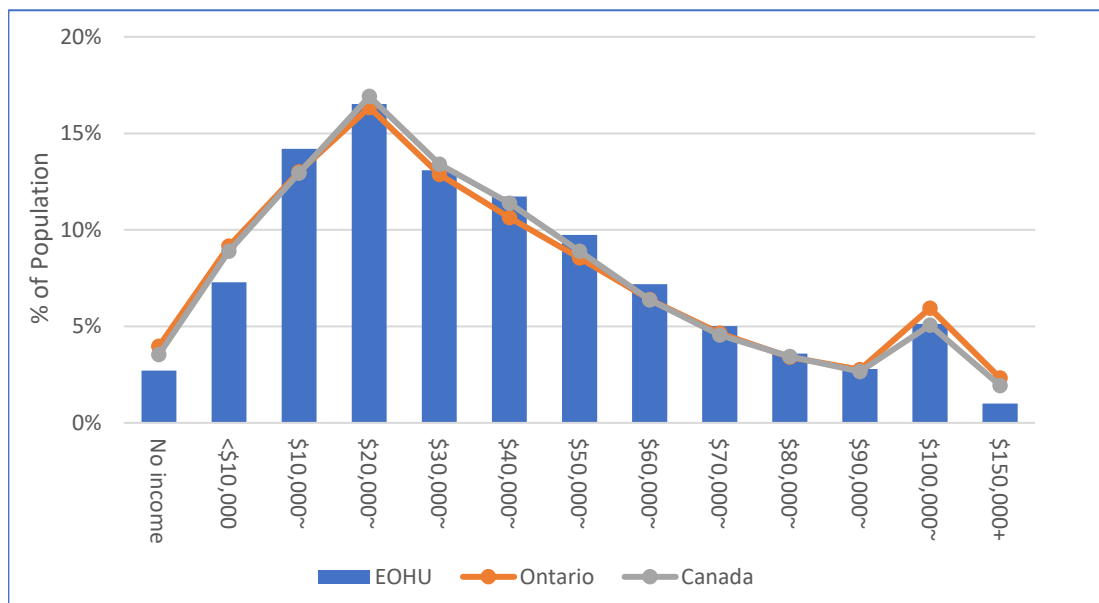

Figure 12. Income Distribution for Aged 15 Years+ in Private Households, Both Male & Female, 2020

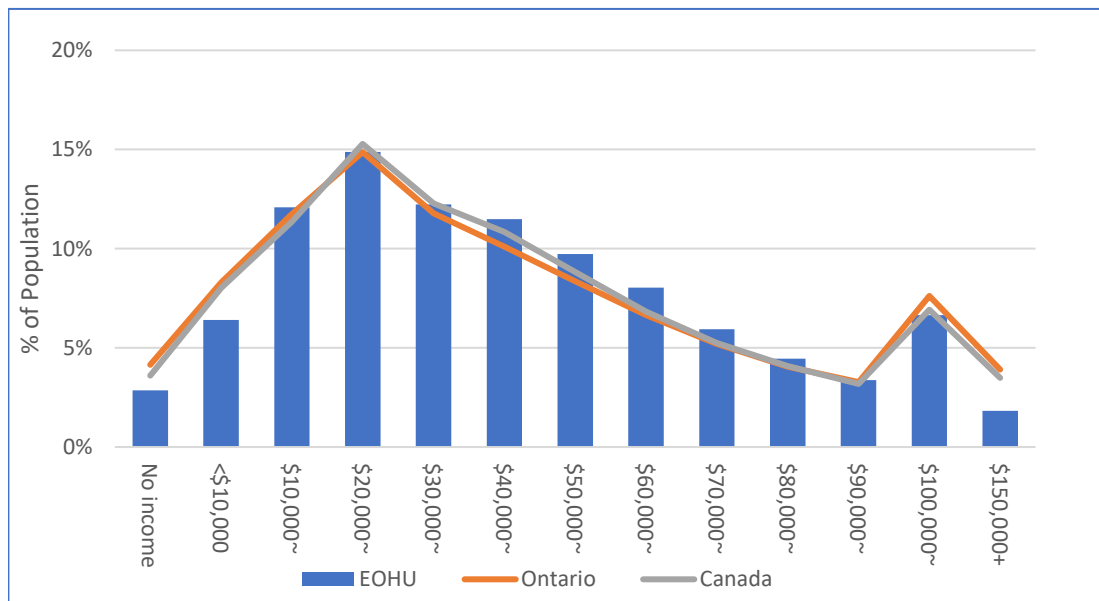

Figure 13. Distribution of After-tax Income (\$) for Aged 15 Years+ in Private Households, Male, 2020

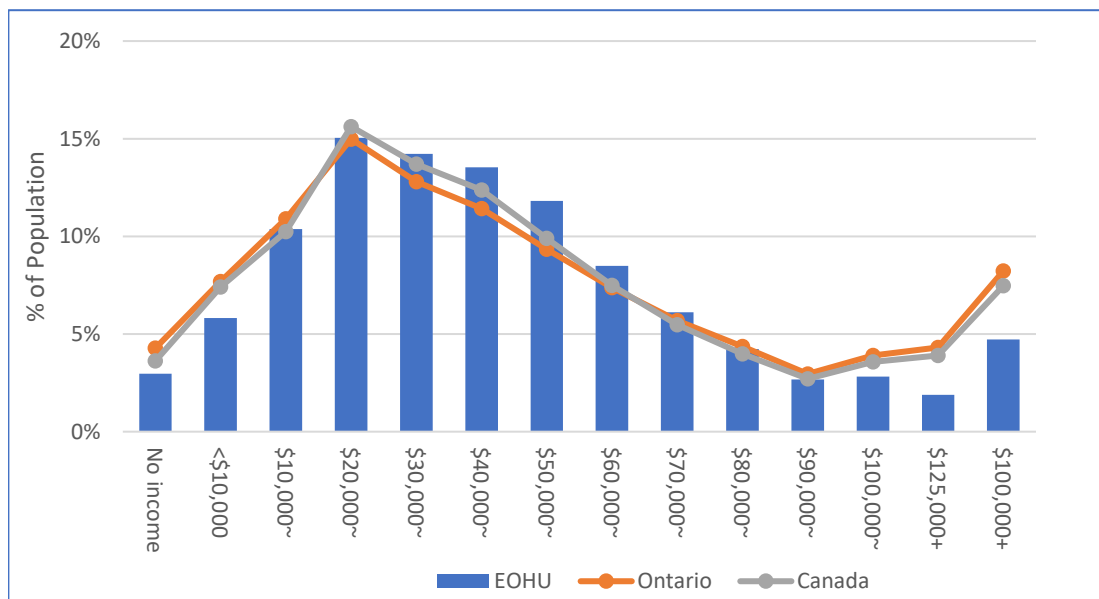

Figure 14. Distribution of After-tax Income (\$) for Aged 15 Years+ in Private Households, Female, 2020

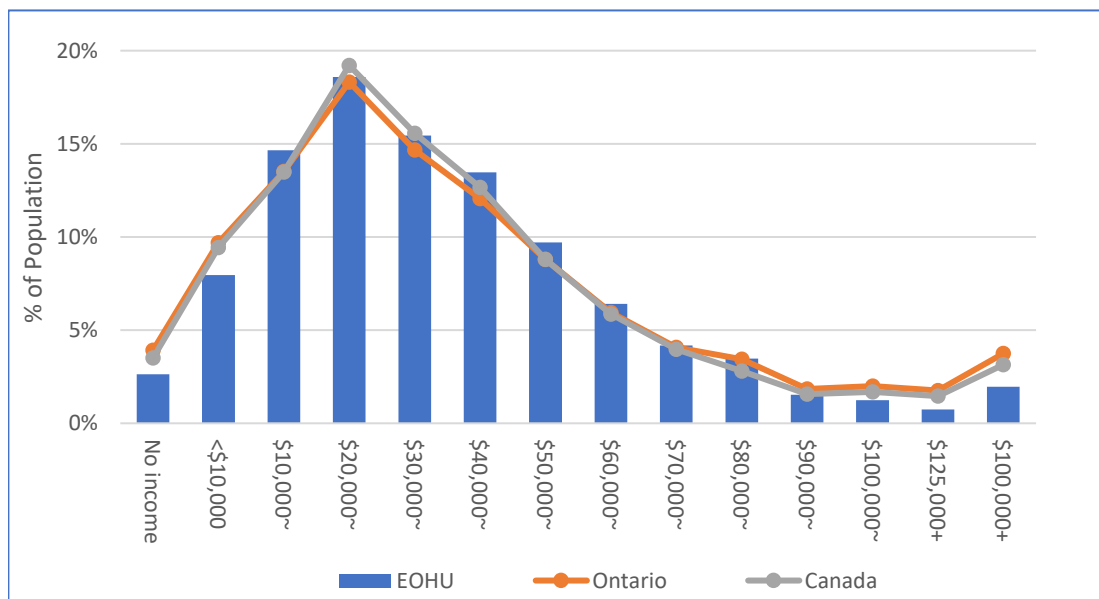
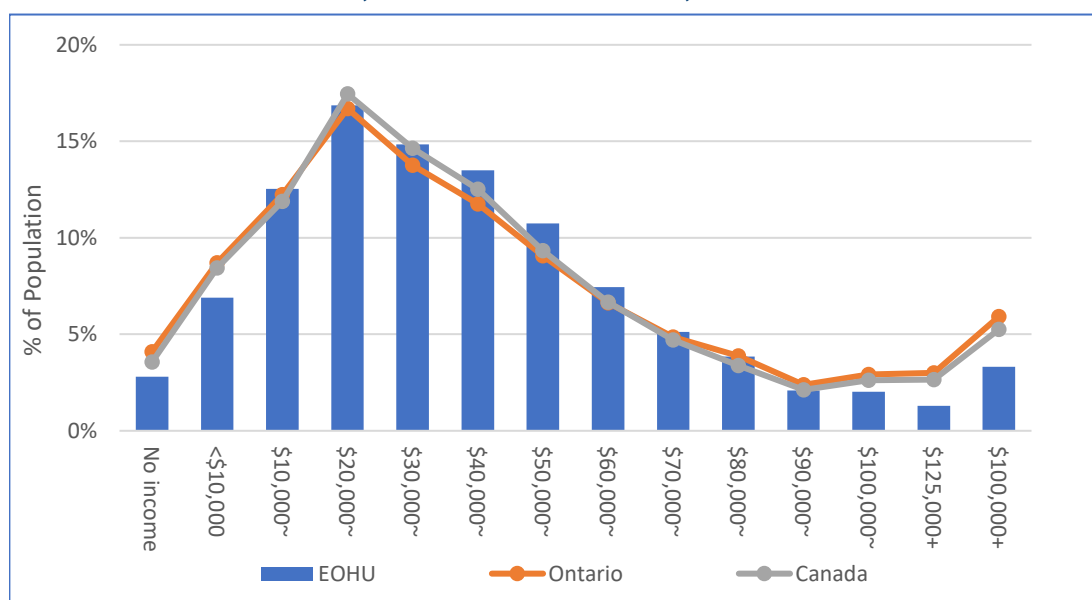
