Figure 01. Age Standardized Mortality Rate for Total Injury, All Ages, 2009-2022

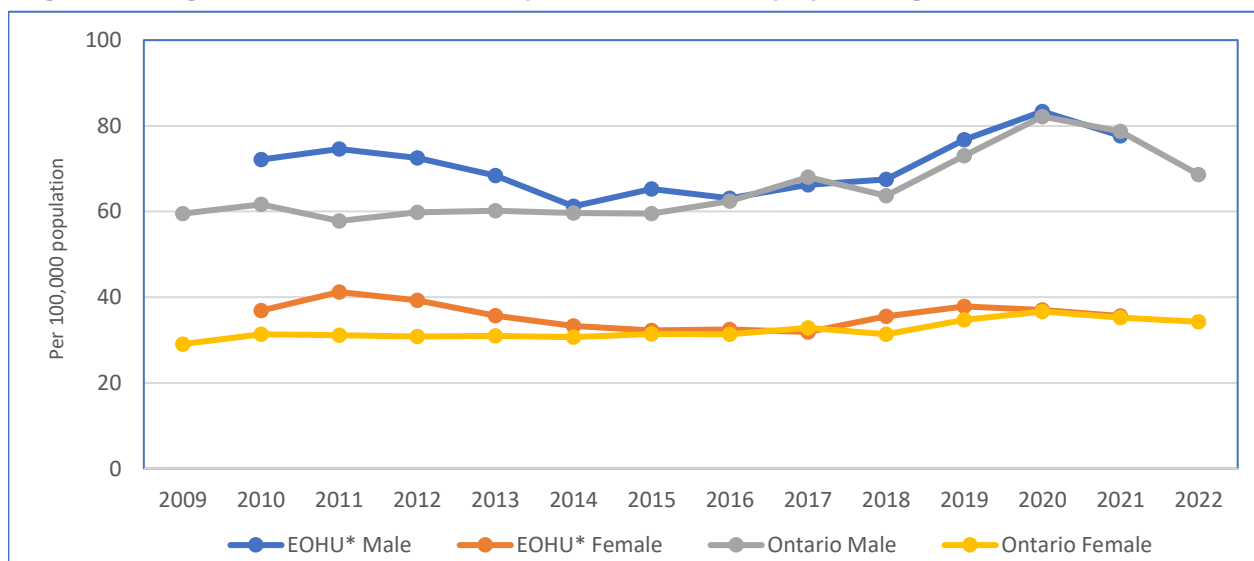
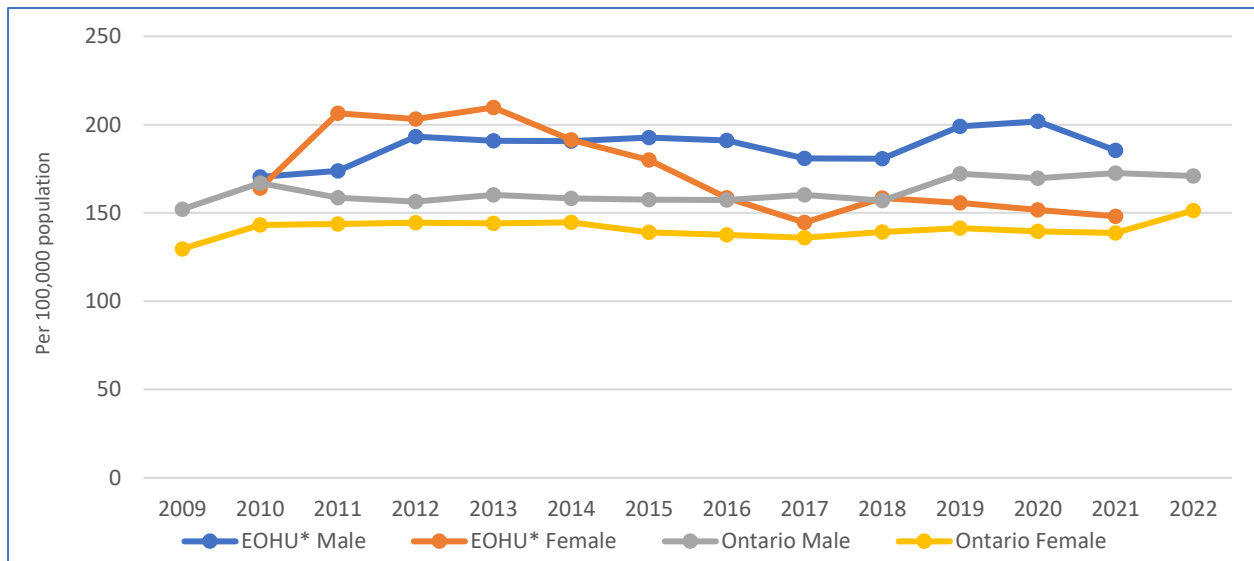
