

CHILD CARE FOR EMERGENCY SUPPORT WORKERS CHECKLIST

IMPORTANT: These precautions must be followed in addition to usual outbreak precautions.

- Complete daily health assessment for every child.
- Wash hands when entering the childcare setting.
- Reinforce handwashing after toilet use, before meals and between activities.
- Review basic hygiene principles.
- Staff and children should remain in designated areas and designated groups.
- Limit staff movement between daycare sites/sections.
- Any activities must allow as much social distancing as possible (including outdoor activities).
- Isolate symptomatic children until parents can pick them up and report to public health.
- Exclude ill children, children with ill household members and ill staff.
- Increase routine cleaning and disinfecting. Clean with soap and water, rinse with clear water and disinfect area respecting the contact time of your disinfectant.
 - All commonly touched surfaces such as light switches, door handles, handrails, twice per day or more.
 - Mouthed toys must be removed immediately after use for cleaning and disinfecting.
 - Toy cleaning must be done in between activities.
 - Beds and cots must be cleaned and disinfected after each use.
- Avoid sharing toys.
- Keep all personal items separated.
- The following are prohibited:
 - Sensory play (water tables, sand tables, dry food, wet food)
 - Group culinary activities
 - Toys that you cannot clean and disinfect such as stuffed toys, dress up clothes, books, cardboard blocks.
