

Preparing for your annual inspection

Please complete the following tasks before the inspection:

- 1. Complete the inspection preparedness checklist**
- 2. Review and update the following policies:**
 - a. Emergency plan (loss of power, loss of water, etc.)
 - b. Medication administration
 - Ensure all the steps for dispensing medication are clearly outlined.
 - Include storage, labelling and documentation procedures.
 - Include steps for when residents refuse medication.
 - c. Infection control and outbreak manual
 - Ensure proper hand hygiene, PPE use, staff training, and audits.
 - Provide a clear protocol for identifying, reporting, isolating and managing outbreaks.
 - d. General housekeeping and laundry
 - Ensure proper cleaning protocols (e.g. procedures to clean bathrooms, residents' rooms).
 - Maintain a cleaning schedule.
 - e. Pet policy
 - Include vaccination requirements and make a copy of the vaccine record to show PHN during inspection.
 - f. Footcare and personal service setting (PSS) policy
 - Include agency agreements.
 - Include last inspection from health unit. If PSS is not inspected by the health unit, please register using this [link](#).
- 3. Ensure proper housekeeping and cleanliness**
 - a. Conduct cleaning of all common areas, bedrooms, kitchens and bathrooms.
 - b. Clean all high-touch surfaces.
 - c. Ensure cleaning schedules are posted and followed.
 - d. Ensure garbage disposal area is clean and pest-free.
- 4. Complete the menu assessment tool.**
 - a. Consult the [Menu Planning Resources for Living Establishments](#) webpage.
- 5. Ensure adequate stock for:**
 - a. gloves
 - b. masks
 - c. gowns
 - d. face shields
- 6. Check that there is a **hand washing or disinfection sticker** in all shared bathrooms and at each hand washing or disinfection station. Replace any missing or badly damaged stickers.**
- 7. Check that there is a “**no smoking**” sticker in all bathrooms (including bathrooms in residents' rooms) and on all exterior doors. Replace any missing or badly damaged stickers.**
